HANARO Symposium has been held annually since 2000 for the promotion of utilization of HANARO research reactor and it has been held every 5 years as an international symposium.

The 2019 International HANARO Symposium will be jointly held with the 60th anniversary celebration of the Korea Atomic Energy Research Institute (KAERI). The symposium is co-hosted by KAERI and Korean Nuclear Society (KNS). In addition, the IAEA Workshop on Sustainability and Self-Reliance of National Nuclear Institutions in Asia-Pacific Region will be held as a satellite meeting. These events will be held at National Science Museum and Daejeon Convention Center (DCC) in Korea from 10 to 12 April of 2019.

- Sustainability and Self-reliance of Research Reactors at National Nuclear Institutions (NNIs), as part of the IAEA satellite workshop
- Design, Construction, and Operation of Research Reactors (Including Safety, Protection, and Regulations)
- Neutron Scattering and Imaging
- Neutron Irradiation Test, Neutron Activation Analysis and Other Nuclear Analytical Techniques
- Radioisotope Production and Applications
- Any Other Contributions Related to Research Reactor or Neutron Sources
